

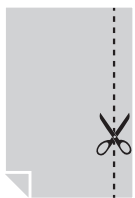

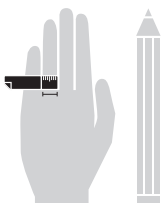
Cut a thin strip of paper or a fine stitching yarn, i.e. 10mm (1cm) thick and 40-80 mm (4-8cm) long. The thickness of the paper or yarn allows fewer errors in measurements due to its wider surface.

Wrap the strip of paper around the area of the finger where you are supposed to wear the ring. The strip must neither be wrapped too tight nor too loose around the finger.

Mark the spot where the paper meets and measure the distance with your ruler. The images will help you to further understand the procedure.

Finally, take the measured length of the paper and compare it to the following table in order to find out the respective inside diameter and size of the ring. If the measurement falls somewhere in between two whole sizes, we recommend you to choose the bigger size.
